

Product & equipment essentials for acrylic nails

At Meraki Nails UK, I'm here to simplify your journey as a beginner nail tech. Here's a checklist with recommended products and equipment you need to provide acrylic nail services.

This list serves as a guide so you can choose to purchase some and not others using it as a reference. You can also print it out, or use as a digital guide.

Disposable gloves
Face masks
Disposable tablecloths
Kitchen towels
Lint free wipes
Nail desk
Height adjustable chair
Hand rest
Desk lamp
UV/LED nail lamp
Nail display sticks to display gel polishes/acrylic powders
Nail dust collector
Hand sanitiser
Nail polish remover (acetone or non-acetone)
Cuticle pusher
Cuticle nippers (optional)
Nail files (100 arit & 180 arit recommended to start)

- E-file with drill bits (cuticle bit & removal bit to start)
- Duster brush
- □ Nail tips (recommended to get different shapes for ease.
 - e.g. square, almond, stiletto)
- Nail buffing blocks
- Nail dehydrator (or rubbing alcohol, also known as isopropyl alcohol)
- Nail primer (acid-free recommended)
- Nail tip cutter/scissors to cut nail tips
- Nail cutters
- 🗌 Nail glue
- Top coat (no-wipe recommended)
- Base coat
- Acrylic liquid (also called monomer. EMA monomer recommended)
- Brush cleaning solution & brush cleaning cup
- Acrylic powder core powders recommended (e.g. nude, white, clear to start)
- Acrylic powder coloured acrylic (optional)
- Acrylic kolinsky brush recommended size 12 minimum
- Dappen dish for acrylic liquid
- 🗌 Hand cream & cuticle oil

- □ Nail art: liner brushes, nail art palette, rhinestone gel glue, nail dotting tool, nail art decals/crystals, chrome powders and tweezers
 - Gel polishes (can start with the basics e.g. black and white)
- Acetone
- Nail soaking bowl for removals
- Cotton wool and foil for removals
- Protective eyewear/visor
